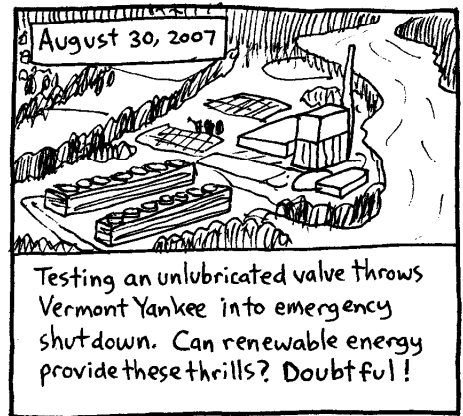
GREAT MOMENTS IN NUCLEAR HISTORY



In Hiroshima and Nagasaki, Japan, U.S. conducts first-ever public demonstrations of nuclear power.

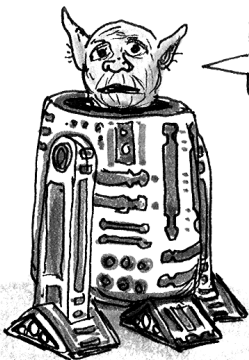


Entergy demonstrates nuclear's resilience when Vermont Yankee continues to run at half its recently-updated capacity after a cooling tower collapse.

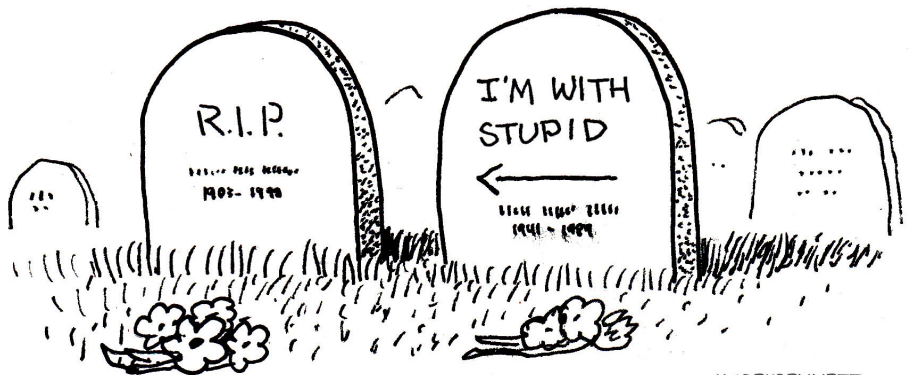


Testing an unlubricated valve throws Vermont Yankee into emergency shutdown. Can renewable energy provide these thrills? Doubtful!
